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### **Emergency Contact**

If my child should become sick or injured, and her/his parents/guardian cannot be contacted at the numbers listed on the registration form, a licensed Physician has my permission to treat the sickness or injury. Please note that OSC will not administer any medication for your child. If your child requires medication, you must come on site to administer it. My child has the following physical limitations, or special conditions:

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**Medical Release** – I agree to have my child participate in the program(s) indicated on this form. I assume all risks to my child associated **with** the program(s) held at OSC Computer Training School. The program may include, craft, and crafting as indicated on the program description. All areas contain. I agree to hold harmless the OSC Computer School and employees and any cosponsor of the activity, from and against all liability for accident or injury to my child arising out of participation in this program.

**Behavior Policy** – Please read the following sections on Cooperation, Violent Behavior and Internet Safety **with your child** to ensure that he/she understands what is expected. Please have your child sign the bottom of this page.

1. **Cooperation** – Courtesy and cooperation are an important part of learning together. Behavior from children who are continually disruptive, who use inappropriate language or tease in an unfriendly manner will not be allowed. Consequences for this behavior will be as follows: the child will be given a verbal warning, if the behavior continues, the child will be removed from the class and the parent/guardian notified. After a conference with the parent/guardian a decision may be made by the instructor to dismiss the child from the program and no refund will be made.
2. **Violent Behavior** – Violent behavior such as hitting a class mate or instructor, pushing or shoving, or destructively breaking items that do not belong to the child will not be allowed. The child will be removed from the class and the parent/guardian notified. After a conference with the parent/guardian a decision may be made by the instructor to dismiss the child from the program and no refund will be made.
3. **Internet Safety** – Class activities using the computers is structured and instructional. Students are not allowed to browse the internet at anytime during the camp hours, unless requested to do so by the instructor. Participation in the Digital Arts Camp requires students to follow instructions in order maximize their learning. If a child chooses not to follow along in the instructional material, they have a choice to work on traditional art projects, origami or play chess. If a child disobeys the internet safety rules after their first verbal warning, they will be removed from the class and the parent/guardian notified. After a conference with the parent/guardian a decision may be made by the instructor to dismiss the child from the program and no refund will be made.

**Media Release** – I understand that my child may be photographed or recorded during his/her participation in this program. OSC Computer Training may use these photographs or videos in future advertising of the Digital Arts Camp program.
